This is the third consecutive year InfoCision has been in the top 10.

From the top down, InfoCision's culture succeeds because it's the small things that matter – like recognition through something as 'small' as birthday cards sent to staff; to hot dog cookouts and pizza parties; to the monthly Employee of the Month recognition ceremony where outstanding employees are recognized by senior management at each of the company's call center locations.

Even with 4,000 employees, this unique work environment can be seen and felt on a daily basis at any of the 15 locations InfoCision calls home. InfoCision doesn't just say employees are its greatest assets; it shows them by making their health and wellness a top priority. Over the last four years the company has invested hundreds of thousands of dollars in employee health and wellness programs.

To ensure employees have convenient and affordable access to fitness programs, the company has installed on-site fitness centers. **InfoFitness** features state-of-the-art equipment and costs only \$3.50 per week. A dedicated, full-time health and wellness coordinator, who is also a certified personal trainer, is available to help members at no extra charge and to instruct fitness classes for groups of employees.

Through **InfoWellness**, which includes an on-site physician, employees have convenient access to all the services of a primary care physician by simply walking down the hallway. The physician is oncall 24 hours a day and any employee can see the doctor for a nominal co-pay. And, so employees don't have to use their personal time to fill prescriptions, there is a prescription delivery services at the corporate InfoWellness center.

Some of the other employee amenities offered include:

- **Subsidized weight loss and fitness programs** where most recently 900 employees walked close to 450,000 miles. In another program 100 people participated and lost a total of 947 pounds and the two winners each won \$800.
- **InfoCision Management Corporate University** was created to provide employees with a clear path for advancement as well as the training and development needed to succeed – all at no cost and all on company time.
- **Telly's Deli**, InfoCision's on-site deli at corporate headquarters, offers convenient operating hours for breakfast and lunch, featuring healthy hot and cold meals, snacks and gourmet coffee. Take-out and delivery services are also available. Each of our 15 locations has an outdoor picnic area with gazebos, gas grills and picnic tables for lunchtime cookouts and picnics.
- **Subsidized childcare** is available to our working parents with young children. Parents of school age children are also offered a 20% subsidy for summer-time care. We recently opened our first on-site childcare center, **InfoKids**, which offers exceptional care at discounted fees for employees' children.

Companies across Ohio entered the two-part process to determine the Best Employers in Ohio. The first part consisted of an evaluation of company work policies, practices, philosophy, systems and demographics.
