Some of the requirements to work from home for InfoCision include owning a computer that meets the following requirements: A 17-inch monitor or one with resolution of 1024 x 768; DSL or cable high speed internet access, Windows 2000 or XP, and anti-virus and anti-spyware software. Many fraudulent work-at-home programs promise potential workers the chance to make a large amount of money and guarantee their success. Most of these companies either require the individual to send them money or personal information before an interview is even conducted.
